participating? If you take part in the study:

- You will experience the most advanced Hexoskin Smart Clothing, a wearable device that is designed to monitor various physiological parameters while you go about your daily activities.
- You may help a Canadian technology company better understand a device which may help others benefit in the future.

- A study staff member will reach out to you by phone to further assess your eligibility.
- 1 hour at the day of participation to receive the devices (Hexoskin Medical System and Holter Monitor) and a 5min recording.
- You will be instructed and assisted to perform a 24-hour recording while doing your daily activities (except taking showers or any other activities that may damage the electronic devices).
- You are expected to return the devices to the study site immediately after you complete the 24-hour recording.
- You will be asked to conduct a 10-min survey.
- You may experience minor discomfort when removing the adhesive electrodes.
